The successful applicant will function as the chief technical and deputy executive officer within the Financial Services Commission. He or she will provide technical support to the Director in administering the financial services legislation and implementing Board policies and strategies. He or she will report to the Director and will stand in for the Director during absences of the latter and will from time to time be required to represent the Commission at overseas regulatory meetings.

The successful candidate will be an enthusiastic team player, widely experienced and able to act as a resource person to assist the current regulatory team in their duties and in forging stronger industry and international regulatory links. He or she should be capable of making an immediate contribution to the work programme of the Commission.

This is a senior position within the Financial Services Commission and the successful applicant will need to demonstrate:

- (a) a degree in law, accountancy, finance or other discipline relevant to financial services, with a professional qualification in law or accountancy being preferred, and at least five (5) years' management experience in financial services;
- (b) a sound knowledge of the financial services sectors locally, regionally and internationally as well as a knowledge of financial products and the current international regulatory standards and practices that apply to them; and
- (c) strong management and communication skills.
