The Anguilla Financial Services Commission (“AFSC”) is inviting quotations for the provision of the in-depth review and overhaul of the intellectual property (“IP”) legislation for Anguilla from a qualified legislative expert to modernize the jurisdiction's intellectual property laws—including the Trademarks, Copyright, Patents, and Industrial Designs Acts—to enhance global competitiveness and support digital initiatives. The selected Expert will review existing legislation, draft amendments and regulations, provide a comparative legal analysis of international jurisdictions, and coordinate with local stakeholders to align the framework with global best practices. KEY DELIVERABLES

Key deliverables for this project include a jurisdictional benchmarking report, clean and tracked-change legislative amendment drafts, revised regulations with explanatory notes, a summary table of proposed forms, and regular progress updates, culminating in a final legislative reform package optimized for public consultation and House of Assembly submission.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

Eligible experts (individuals, firms, or consortia) must possess a recognized law degree and common law bar admission, backed by at least 10 years of legislative drafting experience in common law jurisdictions. Candidates must demonstrate deep Expertise in intellectual property law, digital registry systems, and management audit/training techniques, alongside familiarity with WIPO, UKIPO,



CARICOM, and Overseas Territories frameworks. Experience with government digital transformation or small island developing states is highly desirable.
